



Harvest results 2025 – from DFA member companies



Goodvalley Polen, Lukasz Michon, 25 august.

We finished cereal harvest 22 August with very good yields. We are still waiting for corn harvest.

We are achieving better yields than last year, due to favorable conditions in springtime. We have harvested half off the area of winter wheat. Due to the late start of the harvest, we haven't been able to finish yet.

Jasna-Pol, Poland, Jens Møller, 4 September 2025

The 2025 harvest started here at Jasna-Pol on July 10th with seed grass - red fescue. Unfortunately, the same day, the rainy season also started and to date 3 September, we have received 330 mm of rain, which is half a year's rainfall in just one and a half month.

We bought some new wide wheels for grain wagons just after the day, 20 July with 100 mm rainfall and made several twin wheels ready for harvest. Fortunately, the crops were not completely ripe and have therefore not suffered any damage in terms of quality or rental seed.

Fortunately, we had 10 really good harvest days in mid-August, but have had to dry more grain and rapeseed than a normal year.

The yields have been record-high for Wheat and Barley and the grain also has qualities of bread wheat and malting barley.

The yields in rapeseed have again been low this year compared to expectations and compared to yields in other crops. Very late frost in flowering period, pests and crown mold are probably the cause.

In light of the heavy rainfall just before harvest, we are very satisfied with this year's harvest. A large harvest everywhere else in Europe and indeed the whole world, as always, puts great pressure on crop prices.
